## **THE HANG SENG UNIVERSITY OF HONG KONG**

### **Principal Recommended Admission Scheme (2019 entry)**

#### **Objective**

The Scheme aims at giving due recognition to students who have made distinguished achievements in academic and/or non-academic areas such as sports, music, etc., contributed to community services, or demonstrated leadership abilities.

#### **Eligibility**

Students who meet the following criteria are eligible to be considered under the Scheme:

- Local Hong Kong citizen / residents with right of abode in Hong Kong; and
- Applicant of HSUHK degree programme(s); and
- School applicants attending the HKDSE examination; and
- Outstanding academic achievements; and/or
- Distinguished achievements in non-academic areas, e.g. sports, music, arts, etc.; or
- Outstanding leadership qualities, e.g. Head Prefects, Presidents of Students' Unions; or
- Participation in community services

#### **Number of Nominees from each secondary school**

5 nominees at maximum from each secondary school

#### **Number of Admission Quotas under the Scheme**

450 admission quotas

#### **Scholarship**

33 one-off scholarships amounting to HK\$10,000 each will be offered to selected admittees under the Scheme. Updates will be announced if and when necessary.

#### **Submission of Recommendations**

- All recommendations should be **submitted via SCHOOL**.
- School applicants should approach their school principals for recommendation.
- Before joining the Scheme, School applicants must first submit admission application via the HSUHK Online Application System which will open on 17 November 2018 (Sat) or Electronic Advance Application System for Post-secondary Programmes (E-APP) **and complete all the admission application procedures** (including the settlement of application fees).

- Required documents include:
  - a. **Completed nomination form signed by the principal;** and
  - b. **Each nominee’s personal profile and copies of certification/awards**

Notes:

- Documents for submission should be printed on both sides and the pages should be put together by paper clips instead of staples.
- Applications submitted by fax or email will not be accepted.
- Incomplete / late application will not be processed.
- A confirmation email will be sent to the participating School within 7 working days upon receipt of the School’s application.

- Nominees will be considered by all chosen programmes.
- If School would like to recommend students for admission to **BBA-SCM, BSC-AIN, BA-AHCC, BSC-DSBI or BMSIM programme under Study Subsidy Scheme for Designated Professions/Sectors (SSSDP)**, please follow the School Principal's Nominations (SPN) via **JUPAS** in place of this Principal Recommended Admission Scheme.

**Outcome of Recommendations**

The following outcomes will be given to recommendations before the release of the HKDSE examination results:

- a. Conditional offers; or
- b. Bonus points in order to improve the chance of admission to the nominated programme; or
- c. No special consideration

Besides, the nominees with conditional offer / bonus points are required to meet the minimum entrance requirements on the strength of HKDSE examination, i.e. Level 3 in Chinese and English and Level 2 in Mathematics (Compulsory part), Liberal Studies and one elective subject, before they are eligible for consideration for admission.
